

GERMAN SHEPHERD PUPPY FEEDING CHART

Age	Type of Food	Cups/Day	Frequency
Newborn to 3 Weeks	Mother's Milk	-	As needed
3 - 6 Weeks	Puppy Mush & Mothers Milk	-	As needed
6 - 8 Weeks	Puppy Mush & Mothers Milk	-	4 or 5 times a day
8 - 10 Weeks	Puppy Food & Mush	1.5 to 2 cups	3 - 5 times a day
10 - 12 Weeks	Puppy Food & Mush	2 cups	3 - 4 times a day
3 - 6 Months	Puppy Food	2 to 4 cups	3 times a day
6 - 10 Months	Puppy Food/Adult Chow	3 to 4 cups	3 times a day
10 Months - 1 year	Adult Food	3 to 5 cups	2 - 3 times a day
1 year -18 Months	Adult Food	3 to 5 cups	2 - 3 times a day
